

# Ocular Emergencies

Need immediate management to prevent permanent damage with visual loss:

- 1- Ocular Injuries: Rapture globe ,  
Retained F.B (IOFB or EOFB),  
Burns (Chemical or thermal),  
Photophthalmia, .ETC
- 2- Acute congestive Glaucoma: Tension is markedly raised and may lead to loss of vision within 24 hours
- 3- Progressive Corneal Ulcer: As it may perforates
- 4- Severe Infection: Cavernous sinus thrombosis,  
Orbital cellulites,  
Panophthalmitis or  
Endophthalmitis
- 5- Central Retinal Artery Occlusion(CRAO): as visual loss occurs within 30 min
- 6- Spreading Retinal Detachment(R.D): as macula is thretened
